In board books, don't miss **A HOME FOR YOU** (page 3) by Regina Schwarz with illustrations by Julia Dürr: Here, a little squirrel creates the perfect dwelling -- capturing hearts with its charm and creativity.

Within our picture books, we are proud to highlight several that truly stand out: **ANNA'S ANGER** (page 11) is a German classic by Christine Nöstlinger, newly interpreted with stunning illustrations by Anke Kuhl. **COUNT DACKULA** (page 10) by Max Osswald with illustrations by Merle Groll is a delightful tale of a little dachshund who dresses up as a vampire (encouraging everyone to take part in the fun). **SPIKE AND STINK** (page 12) by Juli Wind with illustrations by Ulrike König is a hilarious story of prickly and stinky outsiders who strike up an unlikely friendship.

For our young adult readers, Anna Benning has delivered the second instalment of the **DIVINE LIGHT CHRONICLES** with **TO BREAK A GOD** (page 33). A particularly stunning read is **WE WON'T FORGET THE FIRE** (page 35) by award-winning Sarah Jäger: an insightful and tender coming-of-age novel by a remarkably talented, versatile and already widely translated author.

Finally, in non-fiction, **BEING QUIET IS MY SUPERPOWER** (page 37) by Antje Kunstmann with illustrations by Friederike Ablang champions the strengths of introverted children and points out the benefits of embracing shyness, while **FAKE** (page 38) by Sybille Hein gives its readers funny glimpses of „Fake news“. Don't we all wish these became obvious?
