This picture book offers comfort to anyone who brings opposites together in a family, grows up between two cultures, or has two homes. Because it's wonderful to see the world from more than one perspective.

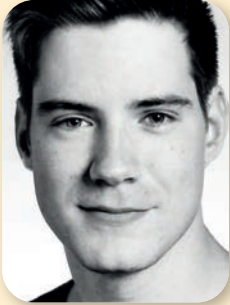
